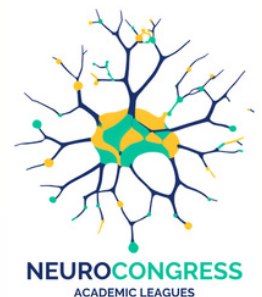

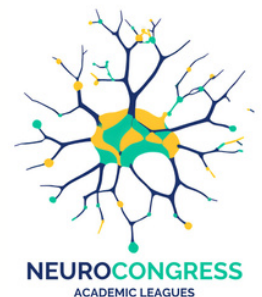
UNDERSTANDING ACADEMIC LEAGUES...

Academic leagues are groups of healthcare students who voluntarily meet each other to discuss and learn techniques in their area of interest. These groups are supervised by professionals who have already graduated and continue in the academic field, guiding the activities.

The academic leagues emerged in Brazil in the mid-1990s, based on students' interest in gaining more knowledge about a particular area of health. The leagues have 3 main objectives:

- 1. Teaching: transmitting knowledge from experts through classes and lectures
- 2. Research: encouraging and supporting students to carry out scientific research and participate in academic events such as conferences and symposia
- 3. Extension: sharing the knowledge learned at the university with the surrounding community.

The University of Campinas (Unicamp) stands for being a pioneer in academic leagues. Over the years, several leagues have emerged and today has more than 1,000 leagues of specialties and diseases, such as surgery, emergency, cardiovascular surgery and others.

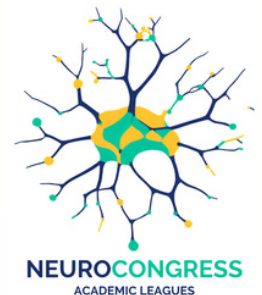


UNDERSTANDING ACADEMIC LEAGUES...

Furthermore, it was at Unicamp that the first Trauma League in Brazil emerged. The **Unicamp Trauma League** has a history rooted in the need to address the growing concerns about trauma-related injuries and deaths, which are a leading cause of morbidity and mortality in Brazil. In 1992, the league was created in response to a national movement in Brazil to enhance the quality of medical education in areas related to trauma and emergency medicine. Initially, it began as a small initiative, focused on providing medical students with additional opportunities for practical, hands-on learning beyond the traditional curriculum.

As trauma and emergency medicine are critical areas in Brazil—due to factors such as traffic accidents, violence, and workplace injuries—the league quickly gained momentum.

The leagues has become an integral part of the medical school's extracurricular activities, attracting students interested in surgery, emergency medicine, and intensive care. Its success has influenced the development of similar student organizations across Brazil, contributing to a nationwide focus on improving trauma care, which we aim to share worldwide through WCTEL.

ABOUT WCTEL

The World Congress of Trauma and Emergency Leagues (WCTEL) is a groundbreaking event, being the first-ever global congress dedicated to trauma and emergency leagues. This pioneering initiative seeks to unite medical students, nursing students, allied health students, along with esteemed professors, researchers, and experienced healthcare professionals from across the globe. The congress is designed to foster an environment that promotes networking, collaboration, and the exchange of knowledge, allowing participants to share innovative approaches and cutting-edge techniques in trauma care and emergency medicine.

The internationalization of trauma and emergency techniques is a key goal of the WCTEL. By bringing together participants from different countries, regions, and healthcare systems, the congress facilitates the cross-cultural exchange of best practices and emergency response strategies, ultimately contributing to a more unified global standard of care. In this way, WCTEL not only serves as an academic forum but also as an agent of change for improving trauma care globally, ensuring that advancements made in one part of the world can benefit patients everywhere.



ABOUT COLT

Every year, the Brazilian Committee of Trauma Leagues (CoBraLT) organizes the CoLT (Brazilian Congress of Trauma Leagues). This congress is 100% organized by medical students and is attended by the greatest names in trauma from Brazil and the world.

CoLT was established in Campinas through the visionary efforts of Dr. Mario Mantovani, with Dr. Gustavo Fraga also playing an essential role in its creation. Both prominent figures in trauma surgery, they sought to create an academic space for collaboration, skill-building, and knowledge exchange among medical students passionate about trauma and emergency care. Created under CoBraLT, CoLT held its first edition in Campinas, in 1999, setting the city as the birthplace of what would become one of Brazil's most important academic gatherings in trauma medicine.

Since that initial congress, CoLT has grown significantly, bringing together healthcare students, experts, and professionals for hands-on workshops, realistic simulations, and research presentations each year. Campinas has hosted key editions in the congress's history - besides the first edition of CoLT, in 1999 -, in 2008 (10th edition) and 2017 (19th edition), strengthening its reputation as a leading center for trauma education, supported by institutions like Unicamp, which offer state-of-the-art facilities and have set high standards in training.

Furthermore, CoLT adapted quickly to the challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic, holding its 2020 edition (XXII CoLT) entirely online to ensure the continuity of trauma education and collaboration. Organized by that year's management team of the Brazilian Committee of Trauma Leagues (CoBraLT), this virtual CoLT provided students, professionals, and trauma care enthusiasts with a valuable platform for learning and networking despite the restrictions of the pandemic.

In the 2024 edition, the XXVI CoLT took place in São Paulo, with the 16th Congress of the Brazilian Society for Integrated Care of the Trauma Patient (SBAIT) as part of Trauma Brasil 2024, and was attended by 480 registrants.

Building on this legacy and with the expectations of an even bigger event, with more attendants and presentations, Campinas is once again the chosen city for the 2025 edition, where it will host the XXVII Brazilian Congress of Trauma Leagues (CoLT) along with the inaugural World Congress of Trauma and Emergency Leagues (WCTEL). This collaboration embodies CoLT's commitment to tradition while expanding to a global platform through WCTEL, further establishing Campinas as a prominent hub for excellence and innovation in trauma and emergency care worldwide.

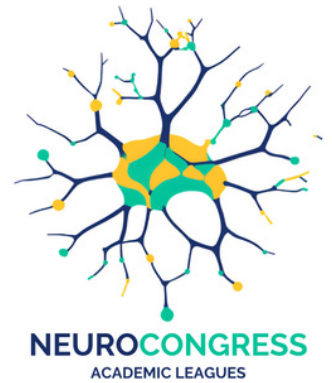


We are thrilled to announce the 8th Brazilian Congress of Academic Leagues of Angiology, Vascular and Endovascular Surgery, to be held from July 3rd to 5th, 2025. This time, in association with the World Congress of Trauma and Emergency Leagues (WCTEL), we anticipate a valuable enrichment in the development of our activities. The Congress will be held at Unicamp in Campinas, supported by the Brazilian Society of Angiology and Vascular Surgery and, featuring the participation of various academic leagues from all over Brazil, including the Paulista Academic League of Angiology and Vascular Surgery, which comprises 16 leagues from institutions across São Paulo state.

The 1st Brazilian Congress of Academic Vascular Surgery Leagues was held in São Paulo at the Paulista Medical Association in 2016. Subsequent events took place in 2017 in Natal during the 42nd Brazilian Congress of Angiology and Vascular Surgery by SBACV, in 2018 at APM in São Paulo, and in 2019 in Recife during the 43rd SBACV Brazilian Congress. Due to the pandemic, the 2020 and 2021 events were held online, and in 2022, we organized it in conjunction with the 43rd SBACV Brazilian Congress.

We hope to have the participation of students from across Brazil and are dedicated to making this a remarkable.

BRAZILIAN CONGRESS OF NEUROLOGY AND NEUROSURGERY LEAGUES

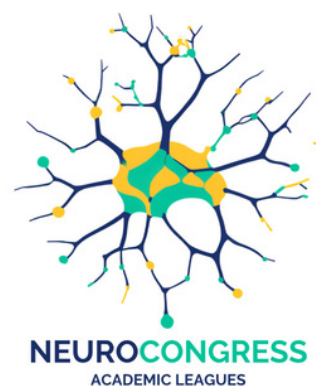


Healthcare and neurosciences are experiencing rapid transformations worldwide, with significant advancements and innovations redefining their landscapes.

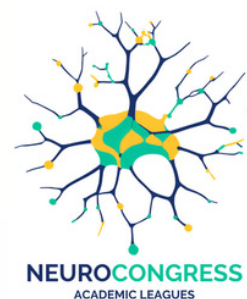
PROGRAMME

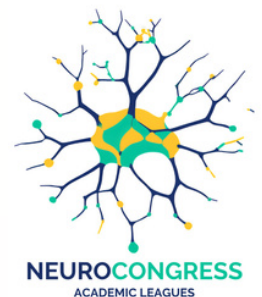

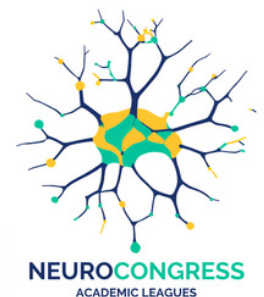

- Groups of 8-10 students attending congress will accompany internships in different areas at HC Unicamp



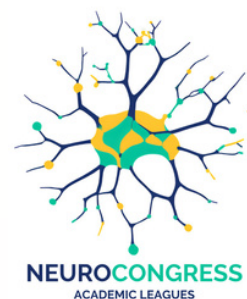
